Thanks to EPI-USE staff's fundraising efforts to benefit the community at Kekana Gardens, adjacent to Dinokeng Nature Reserve, we were able to provide plates, mugs, cutlery along with food parcels to Botlhokwa Bja Ngwana Orphans Day Care Centre and Seikokotlolo Old Age Home.



## **HUMAN-ELEPHANT CONFLICT**

Providing a line of beehive fencing between Kwazulu-Natal and Mozambique has to date successfully prevented elephants crossing into the Gazini community in Kwazulu-Natal. At the same time beehives have provided an on-going income to the subsistence farmers and this has encouraged us to expand the project into a wider area in the future. Beehive fencing will now be deployed in Dinokeng.
