ERP IN WATERBERG- EDUCATION AND CONSERVATION

The Waterberg Waves (WW) radio station in Vaalwater, Limpopo continues to promote the ERP vision through a daily programme managed by the experienced conservatist Letitia Mahlaji. Letitia recently organised an event that took place at Lapalala Wilderness School, introducing children from local schools to the importance of conservation.

PFARANANI SKILLS TRAINING CENTRE

ERP recently took over the management of Pfaranani Centre, located in the Kekana Gardens, a community adjacent to the Dinokeng Game Reserve. ERP will be implementing a variety of educational programmes including basic IT training, coding, agriculture and access to information through an internet café. This is an opportunity to promote a classic ERP Hub for the benefit of the local community.



BEEHIVE FENCING

In Gazini (Kwazulu Natal Province) we have completed the first phase of the beehive fence, which now has 46 beehives stretching over just under 1 kilometre in length. This project benefits 10 local community members who have been recently trained as beekeepers. To supplement their income derived from honey, we are in the process of planting chillies as an ongoing intermediary crop. This project is currently being replicated at Dinokeng Game Reserve.



FEEDING OF ORPHANS AND VULNERABLE CHILDREN

This is the remainder of the 5 tonnes of ePap sponsored through ERP and kindly delivered to Ndumo free of charge by Barloworld to benefit the orphans in the area.

We have also purchased and delivered 1 tonne of ePap to feed 52 orphans at Madikwe over the holiday period. The picture shows the caregivers receiving the ePap.
